

A BRIEF OVERVIEW



Ramgarh and Jhaltola

The middle Himalayan region in Kumaon has thick jungles teaming with wildlife, bubbly streams and wide valleys. Ramgarh is a beautiful place set amidst fruit orchards, and Jhaltola is surrounded by 1000 acre of pristine forest and faces the high Himalayan ranges.



Drives in Kumaon

Kumaon is best explored at an easy pace, with short drives as we move deeper into the Himalaya, with daily driving time around 4 hours. The road passes through forests, valleys and small villages and you can glimpse the Himalayan life in slow motion.

ITINERARY: 5-DAY TRIP, 3 DAYS OFF WORK

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Fly into Pantnagar (from Delhi) via the morning 10:50 am flight and from the airport drive to Ramgarh. ~ 3 to 4 hours.

25-27 FEB On 25th we drive deep inside Kumaon, to a forest lodge in Jhaltola. ~ 3-4 hours. 26th we visit a very interesting place and come back to Jhaltola. ~2 hour one way. On 27th we drive back to Ramgarh.

28 FEB Drive back to Pantnagar airport to catch the flight back to Delhi at noon. ~ 4 hours

You can also choose to take the overnight train from Delhi to Kathgodam (23rd night). Or reach Kathgodam a day early, on 23rd Feb, and stay in a hotel of your choice.

Our first night stay is in Ramgarh bungalows, the quintessential Kumaoni lodge.

In Jhaltola we stay in a very comfortable guesthouse with a local family and enjoy their warm hospitality and beautiful views of the mountains. On 26th we have a special outing which we are keeping as a surprise for you. On 27th our return journey starts with the drive back to Ramgarh.

Again, you can choose to catch the morning train from Kathgodam instead of the flight back to Delhi. Book your tickets accordingly.



COST FOR THE TRIP:

Stay and food

On twin sharing basis in Ramgarh and

Jhaltola. Breakfast and dinner included.

Visits, etc. Guide and sanctuary fees, etc., where

needed, is included.

Transportation Included from Pantnagar airport (or

Kathgodam station) and back in SUVs.

The cost of the trip = Rs 45000/- per person including all taxes.

Note: The group size will be limited to 12. You will need to fill the registration form and once your seat is confirmed, make the full payment. Read our cancellation policy and fill the release document.
