


A CWH GROUP HOLIDAY TO GANGTOK. 13 – 17 NOV 2024



SHORT WALKS AROUND GANGTOK

The eastern Himalaya is a special region. Thick jungles and snow-covered peaks are squeezed into a narrow slice of land, making it possible to see some of the highest peaks in the world, like Kangchendzonga, from your hotel room window. It also has a unique culture and cuisine, both worth exploring. This trip is an introduction to eastern Himalaya through short walks in and around Gangtok. The idea is to take it easy, follow the rhythm of the mountains and soak in the essence of the place.

A BRIEF OVERVIEW



Gangtok

Gangtok, the capital of Sikkim, is a worthy destination. It's clean, well-organized, has plenty of places to see, very good food and excellent views of the snow-covered mountains, including Kangchendzonga. It is also a hub to explore Sikkim through short walks and drives.



Around Gangtok

We will avoid the more touristy places and instead opt for the lesser crowded but equally beautiful trails, villages, waterfalls and monasteries around Gangtok. There will be a daily excursion to a nearby place and an evening stroll around Gangtok city.

ITINERARY: 5-DAY TRIP, 3 DAYS OFF WORK (1 WEEKEND)

13 NOV

Fly into Bagdogra and drive to Gangtok.

~ 4.5 hours.

Try and fly into Bagdogra by noon so that we can reach Gangtok by evening. You can reach Bagdogra by train also. In Gangtok, we will stay at a beautiful heritage property.

14-16 NOV

We set into a daily pattern for the next three days. An excursion in the first half of the day and a stroll around Gangtok in the evening.

Post breakfast we will drive to a nearby place and then explore it by foot. The walks will be short and easy. Our lunch will be mostly outside and we will be back in Gangtok for some rest and then go for an evening stroll in the buzzing town.

NOV

Drive back to Bagdogra. ~ 4 hours

We leave early and drive back to Bagdogra to catch the return flight or train. Book your return flight post noon.



COST FOR THE TRIP:

On twin sharing basis. Breakfast and dinner included. Lunch, snacks and

food in transit not included.

Daily walks and Will explore Gangtok and nearby

activities places with a guide where needed.

Transportation From Bagdogra airport and back in

SUVs.

The cost of the trip = Rs 45000/- per person including all taxes.
